Dear Secretary Gates:

As members of the New Jersey Congressional delegation, we write to express our strong support for basing the Light Mobility Aircraft (LiMA) mission at Joint Base McGuire-Dix-Lakehurst (JB MDL), New Jersey. As you move forward with the strategic basing and bed down process decision for this critical national security asset, we believe that the best, most strategic, cost-effective, and logical location for LiMA continues to be in New Jersey at America's premier joint warfighting and air mobility center of excellence and training base. There is no doubt that JB MDL is the ideal military installation for this important mission.

Joint Base McGuire-Dix-Lakehurst far exceeds the objective basing criteria for the Light Mobility Aircraft and has the lowest operating costs of the installations currently under final consideration. Airspace access will be critical to the LiMA mission and JB MDL offers unparalleled airspace opportunities with two fully operating military airfields inside the confines of the JB MDL installation itself, as well as access to airspace over the Atlantic Ocean and at Warren Grove Training Range.

As an Air Mobility Center of Excellence and home to the 621st Contingency Response Wing (CRW), JB MDL leads our nation's ability to meet Combatant Commander needs to train and rapidly deploy personnel to quickly open airfields and establish, sustain, and coordinate air mobility operations in an often austere expeditionary environment. Additionally, the 621st CRW is at the very tip of the spear in developing the building partnership mission set that the Light Mobility Aircraft platform is being acquired to directly support.

The USAF Expeditionary Center, co-located at the Joint Base, is the capstone Mobility Air Force center of excellence for education and training for every facet of air mobility and the LiMA mission's close proximity to it would provide simultaneous resident access to its storehouse of


instruction -- exactly the type of enterprise knowledge the LiMA and Building Partnership missions are designed to impart. Moreover, proximity to the USAF Expeditionary Center would offer equally unmatched opportunities to the larger mobility enterprise for tactics, techniques and procedural development for employing the Light Mobility Aircraft far into the future.






Thank you for your time and careful consideration of this important request in support of America's national security. We look forward to working together with you in support of our nation's warfighters.


